Lanark Lane Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand)

An intense nose of gooseberry, passionfruit and cut grass. Citrus and tropical fruit dominate the clean, refreshing palate showing a characteristic intensity and keen acidity in this delicious Marlborough.

Dom Pérignon Vintage Champagne (France)

Dom Pérignon's creative ambition is a perpetual quest for harmony as a source of emotion. Every creative process faces constraints.

For Dom Pérignon, this means always a vintage. An unyielding commitment to bear witness to the harvest of a single year, whatever the challenges, even going so far as not declaring a vintage.

Jean Biecher Riesling (France)

This lively Riesling has flavours of fresh peaches, lemons, honey and smoke. It has a fantastic elegance and balance. A leading organic producer in Alsace, the Biecher family have been making wine in Alsace since 1776. The wines of Jean Biecher et Fils largely follow the Alsace style, and have helped cement their position as one of the leading producers in the region. Bottle 43.20

Domaine d'Elise Chablis (France)

The Domaine d'Elise is a pocket sized estate of 13 ha which lies at Milly on the slopes above the Premier Cru vineyards of Cote de Lechet. Wines from Frederic Prain have a distinguishing characteristic as he harvests his grapes later than usual in order to get very ripe fruits. Yields are kept low to produce a wine that brings out all the traditional flavours of the region. Fresh citrus and mineral notes beautifully balanced by layers of warm rich fruit. Slightly creamy on the palate with apple and lime fruits and a refreshing acidity.

Bolney Estate Bubbly Brut (England)

Delightful floral and brioche notes combine with zesty citrus fruit, honeysuckle and elderflower for this Sussex sparkling wine. It is delicate and well balanced, finishing with soft fresh hints of sweetness, the perfect English sparkling wine. Bottle 54.90

Court Garden Sparling Rosé (England)

This is our sparkling Rosé, made with a blend of Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes. Very pale peach hue, frothy, dried cranberry, nicely defined red fruit flavours, lively acidity balancing creamy mousse and good weight, resulting in a balanced, savoury finish with a lovely brioche character. Châteauneuf-du-Pape Tradition (France)

A world renowned French wine, with a strict Appellation d'origine contrôlée located around the village of Châteauneuf-du-Pape in the Rhône wine region in southeastern France.

Mostly Grenache, this is a classic & delicious Châteauneuf du Pape. Deep ruby in colour, with an intense, black and red fruits and spices and pepper nose, it tastes fresh and soft with refined tannins and a beautiful cherry finish.

Pierre et Remmy Gauthiers Crozes Hermitage (France)

A high quality red French wine from one of the best producers, this Crozes Hermitage is deep, rich and surprisingly concentrated, it offers classic blackberry, cassis, violets and pepper to go with a medium to full-bodied feel on the palate. The fruit is grown on fertile soil, which encourages plant growth rather than, the more normal, optimal fruit ripening, intensifying the flavour. Bottle 56.00
